



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Will transportation be provided?

During the initial year of the program there are no plans for Wisdom House to provide transportation to its students. It is hoped that interested parents would carpool to get their children to and from Wisdom House. Wisdom House will provide assistance in sharing information with riders and drivers to facilitate coordination of transportation.

If students have a conflict for one semester can they still enroll in the other semester?

The curriculum for Wisdom House is designed to be developmental. The sequence of classes from semester to semester and year to year will “spiral” student knowledge and understanding. Concepts will be introduced at one level and reviewed at the following level with new, developmentally appropriate material added to deepen and broaden their understanding. Students with conflicts should not however be discouraged from late entry or re-entry as they should be able to begin their study when ready and grasp the essential elements regardless of the entry point.

Is there financial assistance available?

Interested persons have expressed willingness to “sponsor” a child or children in need of tuition assistance. If parents and students wish to obtain the benefits of Wisdom House, finances should not stand in the way. It is important that parents notify the administration of this need for tuition assistance at the time of enrollment.
